I have also been approached about animals both inside and outside the meeting. Our landlord has indicated that he does not want animals on this property at all. He and other tenants found feces around the property and don’t want animals around here at all. We have a no pets policy here in the room, so I would ask anyone that have animals, unless they are certified service dogs, to keep your animals at home or in your vehicles. As far as violence/and or threats of violence, we have Emergency Procedure Processes posted on both the wall and in secretaries binders. NO one person or even a few people be allowed to disrupt our meetings in or outside our room. They should be asked to leave and if they present any threat at all the police should be called immediately. The Landlord has no tolerance policy and so do we. We are not all things to all people, we are an AA group

whose primary is to carry a message of recover for the Alcoholic. These “other issues” are a distraction from that and should stop. I am asking all members of this group to step up and support the group and meeting secretaries by helping out in these areas when they see htat it is needed.

Finally.....We have compiled a list of items that were brainstormed last month about a possible move and we will continue to look into this going forward. Of we get these other issues under control a then I am sure that we are headed ro revitalization of this group and we should be looking forward to a New Year of Great Recovery.
